(1) The form of the verb is changed into past participle (V3); as, She writes a fetter. A letter is written by Rec.

(III) Some vague and indefinite subjects like 'everyone', 'bookle', 'they', "someone", "somebody", "anybody" etc. are dropped when they are thought to be changed into subjects.
